Jean tells a story about the times in Dalry when she worked at the Coates thread mill and walked to work with her father. The Butler family was there at the same time period and Jean talks about the problems that Joseph suffered with crippling arthritis in his hands which caused him to leave his ropemaking trade a find work in brickmaking with the help of James. At Stobswood, Jean was to meet and marry Arnold Defty because the brickyard her father managed was very close to the mines where Arnold worked. The Heaslet family lived in the company managers residence at Stobswood which was called Alma House. The house that Jean lives in, Woodburn House, was the under-managers house.

Notes from Elmer Provost:

"Jack came over from England after the war and was staying with Annie (Williams) Martin and Alva Jay Martin (Phyllis' parents) after they were married Dec.27/1919 here in Edmonton.

I understand that Jack worked on hotel construction in Edmonton and I believe also in Calgary and Banff. When Annie and Jay and their son Alva moved to Calgary in 1921 or 1922 they lost track of Jack.

He was "rediscovered" by his youngest brother Andrew who found that he was farming with his wife Wilda and four children near the town of Metiskow in eastern Alberta. Phyl and her folks visited Jack and Wilda at this farm sometime in the mid thirties.

The next time we heard about them they were on a farm out of Rochester, Alberta -north of Edmonton. Phyl and I and her parents visited them at this new location-I believe it was the summer of 1947. It was around this time I understand that Alva Jay Martin and his friend in the Canadian Legion arranged for Jack to get a full Veteran's Disability Pension. Jack was badly

wounded in the Great War.

Shortly after this they moved to Vancouver/Burnaby area. Jim and Kate Heazlett visited them in Vancouver when they visited Canada in 1948. Phyl and I and our family visited them in 1956. Jack was in poor health then from chronic bronchitis. That's the last contact that Phyl and I had with Jack and Wilda.

Their youngest son Richard visited us a few times and their other son Jack W. Williams and wife Elsie kept in touch with Annie and Alva Jay. Jack W. worked as a school maintenance man in Bruno, Sask. I have not been able to locate him."

John Elliott Williams (1894-1958) - WWI Military Record

John enlisted as a Gunner (Private) in the Canadian Field Artillery (CFA) in Ottawa 26 November, 1915, at the age of 21. His Regimental Number was 305593 and his official records are held in the Canadian Archives in Ottawa under that number. He listed his home as Chesterville, Ontario and his trade as cheese-maker. For next of kin on his Attestation papers John listed his father Andrew at 2426 Humber St, Belfast Ireland. His pay records show that his cheques were originally sent to his brother Robert in Morewood, Ontario (later scratched out and Ormond inserted). Later they were sent to his mother in Belfast. After a period of basic training in Canada (presumably in Valcartier, Quebec) John's unit, the 32nd battery, arrived in England 14 February, 1916. This unit was part of the 9th Brigade, which along with the 8th, 10th and 11th brigades formed the 3rd Divisional Artillery. The unit was stationed for a time at Bramshott Camp followed by further training at Milford. They arrived at the port of Harvre, France on 14 July, 13 days after the battle of the Somme. John was wounded by gunfire on 10 August, 1918. After he recovered from his wound he was to be hospitalized with influenza in October and with pneumonia in November. John soon returned to Canada on the R.M.S. Carmania, arriving in Halifax 30 Dec 1918 and was discharged 20 Jan 1919 at Ottawa. His discharge papers list him as 5' 3" tall, 135 lbs, blue eyes, light hair, with a distinguishing mark of a "6 inch scar G.S.W. left buttock Aug 10 1918, France". (GSW = gun shot wound). Upon discharge John indicated that he was going to Chesterville to be a farmer.

Notes for Alva James Martin:

Alva James Martin lost his life September 12, 1944 when his aircraft crashed in Italy. He was buried by members of the Allied army at the scene of the accident near St. Fortunata, southwest of Rimini.

Alva had joined the R.C.A.F. in Calgary in 1941 and trained as an observer, graduating in Lethbridge in 1942. He went overseas in August 1942 and received his commission in April of 1944 after serving in North Africa and Italy for 21 months. Petty Officer Martin was born in Edmonton and was educated at Balmoral and Crescent Heights high schools. His younger brother, Flight Sargent David Arnold, was on operational training in England as an air gunner. His service number was J/87018.

At the time of his death, Alva was serving in 104 Squadron of the RAF Bomber Command which was flying the Douglas A-20 Boston bomber. Alva's aircraft was BZ499, which may have been the Boston IV model (Douglas A-20J). This aircraft normally had a three man crew (pilot, bombardier and gunner). The A-20G (called the "Havoc" by the Americans) was the most common model produced. It had a solid nose whereas the A-20J (Boston IV) which also served with the 104th had a glass nose to increase visibility for the bombardier. In April 1943 the 104 Squadron had converted to Bostons from the Blenheim IV bomber and moved to Sicily, moving on to Italy (Falconara) in October. Here the Squadron attacked enemy communications and airfields until the end of the war,

Notes for Wilfred Raymond Provost:

Wilfred Raymond Provost was born on Oct.24, 1895 on the Provost homestead on the SW 1/4, Sec. 30, Tp.46, Rg. 24, W 4th. Meridian. in the Peace Hills Area east of Wetaskiwin.

He went to school as far as Grade 8, in the Separate School in Wetaskiwin. He stayed with his sister and her husband Annie & Henry Laushway while attending school.

He enlisted in the Canadian Army on May 6, 1918 and served in the 1st. Depot Battalion of the Canadian Expeditionary Force. Trained at the Sarcee Military Camp in Calgary, at Camp Petawawa in Ontario and Aldershot in England. The war was over just before he was to be sent to the Western Front in France.

He returned home from England in 1919 and was discharged from the army then. His regimental number was 3208513.

He married Mabel Fraser in 1920

He took at least one automotive mechanics course and then went to barber school in Edmonton and then moved to Hughenden where he owned a barbershop until 1931.

When the depression hit in 1929 the barbering business went flat and in 1931 he moved his family

back to Wetaskiwin where he worked for a Hugh Wolfe in Wolfe's Barbershop.

In 1935 he signed a Purchase Agreement with Harold Moore to purchase Moore's farm on the NW 1/4 of Sec 29, Tp 46, Rg. 24, West of the 4th Meridian and rented the NE 1/4 of Sec 30, Tp 46, Rg 24, W4th.

He moved his family from Wetaskiwin to the farm at Easter time in April of 1935. This farm was just kitty corner from the original Provost homestead where his brother Joseph and family resided and where he was born. The Provost children went to school in the Peace Hills School located a mile west of their place.

The winter of 1935/36 was the coldest winter in living memory and that winter on the farm was very difficult since we had not been able to get in the usual stockpile of wood and every day was spent seeking and cutting sufficient dry wood to cook and heat by. Mrs. Provost (nee Mabel Fraser) developed pneumonia in Jan of 1936 and was very ill for one full month.

In 1955 he sold the farm and held an auction sale to get rid of all the machinery and moved into a house in Wetaskiwin. He worked for an implement dealer in Wetaskiwin (Pahaul) for a short while then he took a barbering exam to reestablish his barbering licence and then moved to Calgary where he worked in a barbershop for awhile, then took over the ownership and ran it until 1964. He and Mabel had purchased a house at 4006-15A St. SW. in Calgary.

His wife Mabel passed away during an operation for colon cancer on Jan. 19, 1962.

On April 15, 1964 he married Annie Houston Martin nee Williams. Later that year he retired from barbering.

He and his new wife lived in her home at 1921-23 Ave. N.W. in Calgary.

Wilfred passed away early in the morning of July 14, 1984, in the Calgary General Hospital. He would have been 89 years old in Oct. He is buried alongside his first wife Mabel in Queen's Park Cemetery in Calgary. His second wife Annie who died in 1989 is buried beside her first husband Alva Jay Martin in the same cemetery and immediately adjacent to Wilfred and Mabel Provost.
