Perth Courier, November 16, 1917

Ernest Coutts, son of Mr. and Mrs. Archie Coutts, of Rideau Ferry, has been awarded the Military Medal for bravery on the field and has forwarded it to his parents here. He went overseas with the Army Medical Corps enlisting at Paris, Ontario with the first contingent. He has been in France for two and a half years. He is a graduate of the Collegiate and a druggist by calling.

Perth Courier, Oct. 21, 1898

Coutts—Died, at Kingston on Sunday, Oct. 15, Annie Wilhelmina Coutts, daughter of Mr. John Coutts, formerly of Oliver's Ferry, aged 28.

Perth Courier, June 8, 1923

Coutts—Birth, at Rideau Ferry, on Wed., May 23, Mr. and Mrs. George Coutts, of a daughter.

Perth Courier, June 27, 1902

The remains of William Coutts arrived in Arnprior on the Winnipeg Express Wednesday last week and were conveyed to his home in McNab Township where the funeral took place on Thursday to the Arnprior Cemetery. It had been thought that the deceased must have been killed in a railway accident but death was due to natural causes he having taken ill of inflammation. Deceased was a brother-in-law of George Farmer of this town and brother of John Coutts of Oliver's Ferry.

Perth Courier, Oct. 11, 1895

On Monday George Couttes of Oliver's Ferry, bought from Hon. Peter McLaren the farm owned by him in Kitley a few miles beyond Lombardy consisting of 150 acres, for \$7,500. There are a large number of outbuildings, and a dwelling on the premises. James Couttes takes for himself the homestead farm on Ferry Road, paying his brother and sister \$1,000 each to wife off their share.

Perth Courier, August 25, 1876

Coutts—Died, at Perth on Thursday, 24th Aug., Mr. James Coutts, Ferry Road, North Elmsley, aged 30.

Perth Courier, January 7, 1898

Coutts-McLean—Married, on Dec. 29 by Rev. R.C.R. Sinclair, B.A., at Bethel Church, Oliver's Ferry, Mr. George Coutts of Oliver's Ferry to Miss Edith May McLean, daughter of Archibald McLean of South Elmsley.

Perth Courier, July 20, 1894

Mrs. Elizabeth C. Grieg of Almonte, daughter of the late Mrs. Elizabeth Campbell is also spending a few days at the Ferry with her sisters Mrs. Henry Smith and Mrs. John Coutts.

Bathurst Courier April 16, 1852

Married, on the 6th inst., by Rev. William Bell, James Morrison to Isabella Coutts, both of North Elmsley.

Perth Courier, May 5, 1899

Mr. John Coutts and family have moved back from Barriefield (near Kingston) to Oliver's Ferry and will take things easy working only a small piece of ground. Their old friends welcome them back.

On Sunday last he furnished meals to seventy people, of whom about twenty-six remained over from Saturday until Monday. Already Mr. King has received numerous tributes to the excellence of the meals supplied by him, and they have been well merited. Most of his rooms have been engaged for July and next week his rush will commence. One gentleman who has been at the Rideau for eleven or twelve seasons in writing for rooms said that he intended

coming by train this year so that he might have two extra days at the "Ferry". "The Coutts House" will be a great favourite this year.
